WHEREAS, Requests for qualifications and proposals were requested by the Department of Public Works for Lawn Mowing/Maintenance at City Parks and Park Facilities; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received, opened and publicly read by the City Clerk at 11:30 a.m., Wednesday, March 22, 2023 in the Council Chambers of City Hall and the bidders were as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the lowest bid by United Lawnscape, Livonia, MI, in the amount of \$97,500.00 be accepted and funded from the Park Millage Fund. Approval subject to a written contract acceptable to both the City and the vendor and authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to sign on behalf of the City.
