PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Wayne who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Wayne City Clerk; the office of the Wayne County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is: **Monday, July 18, 2022**
After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Wayne City Clerk's Office, located at 3355 S. Wayne Rd., Wayne, MI 48184 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday – Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Saturday, July 30, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday August 2, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Renewal of 2009 authorized millage to continue at a rate of 0.9358 (about 94 cents per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for ten more years (2022 through 2031). This renewal is projected to generate \$45,074,507 in 2022.
